## Personalization

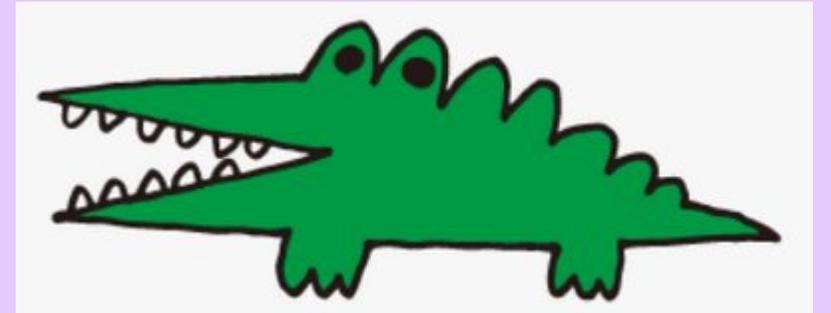
- Make your services yours again! Have everything just how you like it again.

# Google Search

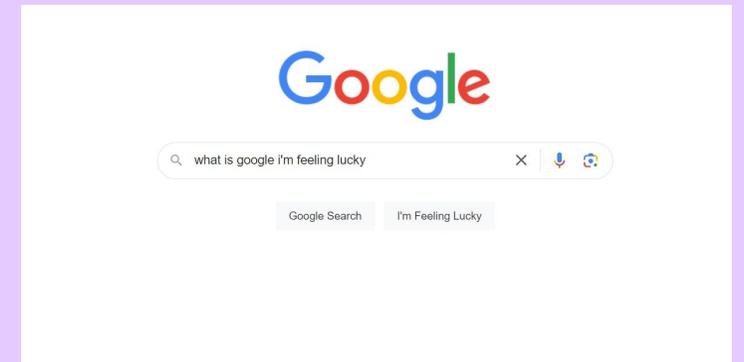
How will you search online?

Alternatives:

DuckDuckGo – Reportedly No Tracking/Logging

Brave Search - Fully Open Source, Efficient, Less Ads

Presearch - Decentralized Search History



# Google Chrome

How will you go online?

Alternatives:

Brave - Efficient, Privacy-focused, Built on Chromium

Firefox - Does not use Chromium, Open Source

Librewolf – Hardened security, Based on Firefox

Tor - Three-node encryption that obscures identity

Mullvad Browser – Built on Firefox, Integrated with Mullvad VPN



# Gmail

How will you message online?

Alternatives:

ProtonMail - Secure, Use Own Domain, Freemium Model

Mail.com – 25 years old, Free except for some features

Preveil - Enterprise software, Free, Encryption

Tuta - Encrypted, Cross-platform, Free option



# Google Drive

How will you store and share things online?

Alternatives:

Cryptpad - Encrypted, Open source

Proton Drive - Bundled with Proton Mail

Syncthing - Open Source, peer-to-peer, encryption

NextCloud - Open source, Integrations, self-host



# Google Workspace

How will you make, view, and share documents online?

Alternatives:

Cryptpad - Variety of document types

NextCloud - Self-hosted with many integrations

Collabora – Open source office suite, freemium

# Google Calendar

How will you keep and share your schedule?

Alternatives:

Etar – Free and open source android calendar

Fossify Calendar – Free and open source

Tuta Calendar – Open source, freemium, cross-platform

Proton – Convenient ecosystem, some features not free



# Google Keep

How will you track notes and to-do lists?

Alternatives:

Notes Foss - Freemium, open source, desktop/laptop app

Obsidian – Personal interconnected wiki, can pay or self-host to share

Logseq – Similar to Obsidian, focus on privacy

# Google Maps

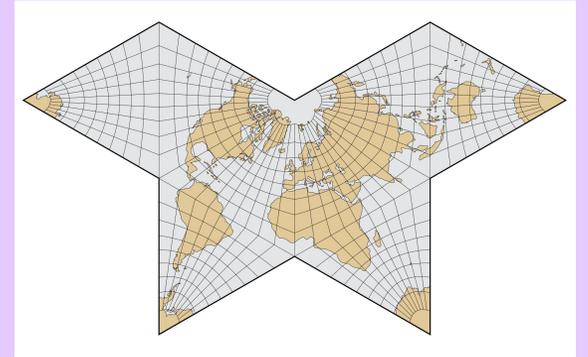
How will you get from place to place?

Alternatives:

OpenStreetMap – free and open source, crowd-sourced data

OSMAnd – freemium GPS navigation and other features

Organic Maps - free and open source, privacy focused

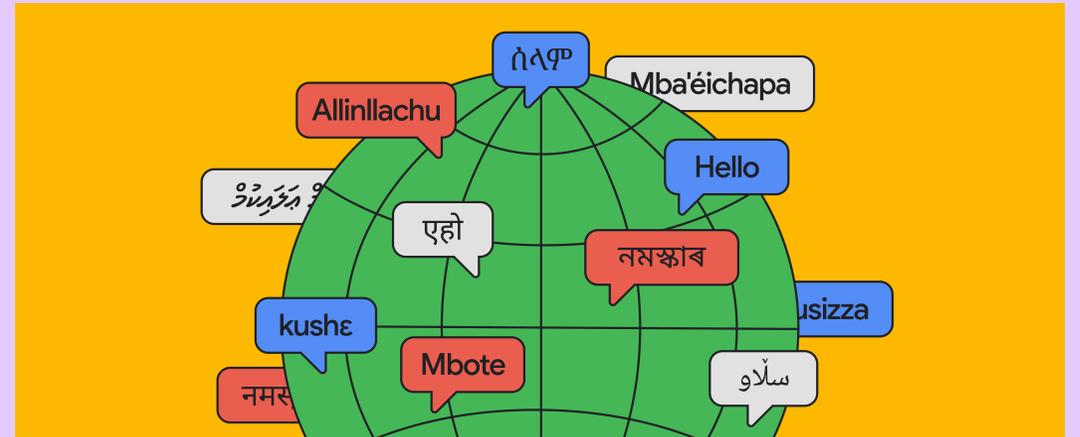


# Google Translate

Alternatives:

Human Translators/Guides

How will you research online?

Alternatives:

Local/School/University Library and their website

Field-specific Journal subscriptions

Academic Institutions' search engine

ERIC (Education Resources Information Center)

iSEEK Education, BASE, CORE



# Google News

How will you get updates online?

Alternatives:

Make your own RSS Feeds from websites you trust



# Google Meet

How will you connect online?

Alternatives:

Jitsi Meet – free and open source

Big Blue Button – free and open source

Discord – freemium, widely available, cross-platform



# YouTube

How will you watch and share videos?

Alternatives:

Internet Archive – free archive of many kinds of media, including videos

Peertube – Similar features as youtube, but independent video website

Patreon – Support creators directly and get access to content and bonuses

Self-hosted blogs – watch and post content with complete control

Local theaters, concerts, and events!

# Android TV/Chromecast

How will you watch stuff on your TV?

Alternatives:

Connect computer with local or self-hosted media files

Create an entertainment center with an old PC using

Kodi

Lineage OS

Plasma Big Screen OS



# Android OS

How will you run your phone?

Alternatives:

GrapheneOS - Pixel devices only for now

Lineage OS – More devices compatible

PostMarketOS - Linux



# Play Store

Where will you get the apps for your phone?

Alternatives:

- F-Droid – download free and open source apps

- Sideload apps yourself – manually add apk files to your android phone

- Installing apps for iOS – you can download apps that will let you sideload apps on iOS



# Play Books

Where will you get your digital books/audiobooks?

Alternatives:

Libby – get ebooks and audiobooks from your local library!

Libro.fm – Buy audiobooks while supporting independent book stores

Bookshop.org – paper books and ebooks supporting independent book stores

# Play Movies

Where will you get your streaming media?

Alternatives:

- Purchase physical media and rip it to a media PC using MakeMKV and handbrake

- Jellyfin – Free and open source self-hosting for your own media

- Plex – Freemium and open source self-hosting for your own media

# Nest/Google Home

How will you manage your smart home devices?

Alternatives:

Home Assistant - self-hosted smart home hub

Home Assistant Green – plug and play HA hub



# Google Messages

How will you text on your phone?

Alternatives:

Fossify Messages – Free and open source SMS with full features

Quik SMS – Free and open source minimal SMS

Signal – Free encrypted messaging

# Blogger

How will you run personal websites?

Alternatives:

- Self host or purchase hosting for your own website

- Ghost – Open-source blog hosting

- HTMLy – open-source website and blogging platform

# FitBit/WearOS

How will you manage your wearable devices?

Alternatives:

AsteroidOS – run linux on your smartwatch

GadgetBridge – open source android app for connecting to smart wearables
